Re: **WATER SERVICE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN YOUR AREA**

Dear Manchester Utilities Authority Customer:

As you are aware, the Manchester Utilities Authority is addressing your service concerns and is embarking on an important project that will improve the water quality, water pressure, and water system reliability in your area. This project is just one of many on-going capital improvement projects that the Authority is accomplishing that will improve the water system and services.

The specific locations where work will occur in the Borough of North Haledon are:

- High Mountain Road (Morley to Chalmers)
- Chalmers Avenue
- Messerve Place
- Rosslee Avenue
- Rothesay Avenue
- Manchester Avenue (Rothesay to Ross)

The project is beginning in July and will continue until sometime in the Fall. Work will be performed during the day time hours.


The majority of the work is the installation of water mains, which will include excavation, pipe installation, backfilling, paving and flushing of hydrants. In order to perform the work, there will be road closures and/or detours, and interruptions of water service from temporary shutdowns of water mains. The Authority and its contractors will work to minimize all disruptions in service. In general, temporary disruptions will be limited to several minutes; however, shutdowns of water mains in some roads may require 1 to 2 hours. Upon completion of the necessary work, service will be completely restored.

Your low pressure service concerns are being addressed and improved through this project. Your water pressure will be increased significantly by the improvements, in most cases to more than 100 pounds per square inch. Based upon this enhancement, the Authority recommends that you contact a plumber to learn whether you may need changes to your internal plumbing, such as a pressure reducing valve or an expansion tank.
